**PRESENT WEATHER:**

**At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression “RAMIL” was estimated based on all available data at 210 km West of Coron, Palawan (12.2°N, 118.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph. It is forecast to move West at 15 kph. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.**
