**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon “QUEENIE” was located based on all available data at 1,080 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (18.2°N, 131.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 200 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 245 km/h. It is moving northwest at 15km/h.
