At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon “QUEENIE” was located based on all available data at **875 km east of Basco, Batanes (19.6°N, 130.3°E)** with maximum sustained winds of 200 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 245 km/h. It is moving northwest at 15km/h.
