### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 AM, 05 September 2017**, Tropical Depression "KIKO" was estimated based on all available data at **355 KM East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.7°N, 125.4°E)**, with maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 kph.
