**AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (FORMERLY TROPICAL DEPRESSION "BASYANG") WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 195 KM SOUTH OF PUERTO PRINSESA CITY, PALAWAN (8.0N, 118.6E). TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT AFFECTING EASTERN SECTION OF SOUTHERN LUZON AND OF VISAYAS. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON**
