Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao. Meanwhile at 3:00PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 1,120km east of Aparri, Cagayan (19.1 degN, 132.2 degE).
