AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **80 KM NORTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (8.8 N, 126.9 E)** WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. MOVING **WEST NORTHWEST AT 30 KM/H**. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
