At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 1,080 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.6°N, 132.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 185 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 225 km/h. It is forecast to move North Northeast at 27 km/h.
