At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 925 km East of Basco, Batanes (20.9°N, 130.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 160 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 195 km/h. It is forecast to move North Northeast at 17 km/h.
