PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "JOLINA" was estimated based on all available data at 400 km Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes or 560 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (15.6°N, 127.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 17 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting the Western section of Luzon.
