Tail-end of cold front affecting eastern section of Southern Luzon. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon and Central Luzon.

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Samar – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan • Leyte – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagnabagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan • Southern Leyte – particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan • Eastern Samar – Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangia and Sulat • Northern Samar – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay • Biliran – all rivers and its tributaries

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zamboanga Sibugay – particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey • Zamboanga del Sur – particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi • Zamboanga del Norte – particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco

No. 05 (Final) for Region XIII (Caraga)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Occasional light rains with isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AGUSAN DEL SUR - particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • SURIGAO DEL NORTE - particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • AGUSAN DEL NORTE - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. • DINAGAT ISLANDS – particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.

With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to take the necessary precautionary measures.
