**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 02:00 PM today, two Low Pressure Areas (LPA) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) were estimated based on all available data at **350 East Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.27°N, 128.9°E)** and at **140 km north of Casiguran, Aurora (17.5°N, 122.3°E)**.
