AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION " KABAYAN" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 335 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF APARRI, CAGAYAN OR AT 300 KM WEST OF CALAYAN, CAGAYAN (19.2°N, 118.6°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 70 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST AT 20 KM/H. MEANWHILE ANOTHER LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 625 KM EAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (8.9°N, 132.0°E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON.

### **No. 11 for Region III (Central Luzon)**

<b>FORECAST 18-HR RAINFALL</b>	Light to moderate rains.
<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Bataan</b> – particularly in Balanga and Morong.</li><li>• <b>Zambales</b> – particularly in Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis.</li></ul>

### **No. 04 for Region XI (Davao Region)**

<b>FORECAST 18-HR RAINFALL</b>	Light to moderate rains with thunderstorms.
<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Davao Del Sur</b> – particularly in Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit.</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Davao Del Norte</b> – particularly in Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang.</li><li>• <b>Compostela Valley</b> – particularly in Matibo and Hijo.</li><li>• <b>Davao Oriental</b>– particularly in Cateel, Dapnan, Baganga Mahan-Ub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casauman, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya and Sumlao/Cuabo.</li></ul>
