At 3:00 pm today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 115°km North of Aparri, Cagayan (19.4°N, 121.6°E). Meanwhile another LPA was estimated based on all available data at 765°km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.9°N, 133.1°E). Southwest Monsoon affecting the western section of Luzon.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bataan - particularly Balanga and Morong. • Zambales - particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis. • Bulacan – All rivers and its tributaries. • Tarlac – All rivers and its tributaries. • Aurora – Rivers and its tributaries particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray. • Nueva Ecija – All rivers and its tributaries.

No. 03 for Region XI (Davao Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains with thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Davao del Sur - particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos, and Padada Mainit. • Davao del Norte - particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug, and Lasang. • Compostela Valley – particularly Matibo and Hijo.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned **still take necessary precautionary measures and are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods.**
