PRESENT WEATHER

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **385 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF SURIGAO CITY, SURIGAO DEL NORTE (9.0N, 128.9E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to heavy rains and thunderstorms over the Bicol Region, Visayas, and Mindanao, particularly in the regions of Eastern Visayas, Caraga, and Davao.

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
PUBLIC WARNING:
