At 4:00 PM today, Tropical Storm "PAENG" was estimated based on all available data at 985 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.5°N, 133.4°E), with maximum sustained winds of 95 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 120 kph. Northeast monsoon affecting northern Luzon.
