At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Storm "PAENG" was estimated based on all available data at 1,102 KM East of Legazpi City (13.1°N, 133.9°E), with maximum sustained winds of 75 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 90 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 15 kph. Northeast monsoon affecting northern Luzon.
