**No. 02 (FINAL) for NCR (National Capital Region)**

With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the Final General Flood advisory for NCR.

**PUBLIC WARNINGS:**

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are still advised to be alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides.
