PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "KABAYAN" was estimated based on all available data including Baler Doppler Radar in the vicinity of San Jose, Nueva Ecija or at **60 km West of Baler Aurora (15.8°N, 121.0°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **65 kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **80 kph**. It is forecast to move **West Northwest** at **20 kph**.
