PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Central Luzon.

No. 02 for Region III (Central Luzon)

Forecast 24-hr Rainfall	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • AURORA particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray

No. 03 (FINAL) for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

Forecast 24-hr Rainfall	Light rains
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • QUEZON particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan. • LAGUNA particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. • CAVITE particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus. • RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.	

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are still advised to be alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides.
