PRESENT WEATHER:

As of 4:00 PM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 85 km East of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.6N, 125.4E) embedded along the Inter Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas. Meanwhile, at 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm (Nepartak) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated at 2,060 km East of Mindanao (9.5N, 145.0E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph. Its forecast to move Northwest at 7 kph.
