Southwest Monsoon affecting Western section of Luzon

No. 01 for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: OCCIDENTAL MINDORO - particularly Abra de Ilog, Caragay, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod. PALAWAN - particularly Abongan, Lian, Langonan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton – Baton, Aramayawan, Iwahig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlungan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. ORIENTAL MINDORO - particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Borac, Bulalacao and Balete.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to take necessary preparedness measures.
