Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Meanwhile, at 4:00 PM today, the center of Typhoon "Ruby" was estimated based on all available data at 720 km East of Surigao City (10.6°N, 132.0°E). It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 kph.

The provinces of Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Ticao Islands and Masbate will have rains while rest of Bicol Region will be cloudy with light to moderate rains.
