PRESENT WEATHER:

Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas. Meanwhile, at 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm (NEPARTAK) outside of the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated at 1,765 KM East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.2°N, 140.6°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 100 KPH. It is forecast to move northwest at 30 KPH.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot) Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan • EASTERN SAMAR particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat • NORTHERN SAMAR particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay • SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan • SAMAR particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan
