



At 4:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 950 KM East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.6°N, 131.0°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
