PRESENT WEATHER:

At **4:00 PM** today, Tropical Depression "BISING" was estimated based on all available data at **385 KM East Northeast** of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (**10.0°N, 129.4°E**) with maximum winds of 45 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 55 KPH . It is forecast to move **North Northeast at 10 kph**. Northeast Monsoon affecting **Northern Luzon**.
