PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm (NEPARTAK) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated at 1,460 KM East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.8°N, 137.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 105 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 135 KPH. It is forecast to move Northwest at 30 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
