PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "JULIAN" was estimated based on all available data at 720 km east of Calayan, Cagayan (19.0°N ,128.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 kph and gustiness of up to 55 kph near the center. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 25 kph. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
