PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Depression "BISING" was estimated based on all available data at 415 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.4°N, 129.5°E) with maximum winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 70 kph. It is forecast to move North Northeast at 11 kph.

AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
