PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Butchoy" was located based on all available data at 1,010 KM East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.2°N, 131.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 185 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 220 KPH. It is forecast to move Northwest at 30 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas.
