PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the Center of Tropical Depression "AURING" was estimated based on available data at 185km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.1N, 128.0E) with maximum winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 70 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 7 kph. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
