Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon. At 04:00 PM today, the center of Typhoon "CHAN-HOM" (International name) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 1,495 KM East of Luzon (18.5°N, 135.8°E). It is forecast to move West Northwest at 20 KPH.
