Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao. Meanwhile at 4:00 am today Typhoon "VONGFONG" outside Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was located based on all available data at 1,700 km East of Northern Luzon (16.5° N, 138.0°E) with maximum winds of 120 kph and gustiness of up to 150 kph.
