PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting Palawan, Visayas and Mindanao. Meanwhile, at 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Depression "ETAU" (International Name) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 1,750 KM East Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon (24.0N, 138.5E) with maximum winds of 65 KPH near the center and gustiness up to 80 KPH. It is forecast to move North Northwest at 20 KPH.
