At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "OMPONG" was located based on all available data at 1,161 km east of Tuguegarao City (17.8°N, 133.0°E) with maximum winds of 215 kph and gustiness of up to 250 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 17 kph. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao.
