<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b>Rivers and its Tributaries in:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>DAVAO DEL NORTE</b> particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Saug, Tuganay and Lasang</li><li>• <b>DAVAO ORIENTAL</b> particularly Catul, Dapras, Mahaneb, Manurigao, Caraga, Sumlog, Casaunan, Guinonoan, Bugnan-Mayo, Bitanayan and Banganga-Mahaneb.</li><li>• <b>COMPOSTELA VALLEY</b> particularly Hijo and Matibo.</li><li>• <b>DAVAO DEL SUR</b> particularly Davao, Padada-Mainit, Lipadas, Tagulaya-Sibulan, Digos, Mainit and Talomo.</li></ul>
