**PRESENT WEATHER:**

**At 4:00 AM today**, the Center of Tropical Depression “AURING” was estimated based on available data **at 100km East Northeast of Tagbilaran City, Bohol (9.9°N, 124.7°E)** with maximum sustained winds of 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 75 kph. It is forecast to move **West Northwest at 9 kph**. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
