No. 04 for Region XI (DAVAO)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and its Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>DAVAO DEL NORTE</u> particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Saug, Tuganay, and Lasang • <u>DAVAO ORIENTAL</u> particularly Catul, Dapras, Mahaneb, Manurigao, Caraga, Sumlog, Casaunan, Guinonoan, Bugnan-Mayo, Bitanayan, and Banganga-Mahaneb. • <u>COMPOSTELA VALLEY</u> particularly Hijo and Matibo. • <u>DAVAO DEL SUR</u> particularly Davao, Padada-Mainit, Lipadas, Tagulaya-Sibulan, Digos, Mainit, and Talomo.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local DRRMCs concerned are still advised to take precautionary measures and be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.
