**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Storm “Ruby” was estimated based on all available data at 370km West of Calapan City Oriental Mindoro (13.7°N, 117.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80kph. It is forecast to move West at 20kph, Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.
