**Present Weather:**

At **4:00 PM** today, Tropical Storm "RUBY" was estimated based on all available data at **350 km Northwest of Pagasa Island, Palawan (13.7°N, 115.8°E)**. It is forecast to move **West at 15 kph**. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

The Regions of Cagayan Valley, Cordillera and Ilocos will experience cloudy to cloudy skies with light rains. Metro Manila and the rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.
