At 04:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon “Falcon” was located based on all available data at 675 KM Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (25.4°N, 126.1°E) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) with maximum sustained winds of 160 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 195 KPH. It is forecast to move Northwest at 22 KPH. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Western Visayas.
