PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00am today, the center of **Typhoon "Dodong"** was located based on Baler Doppler radar and all available data at **240KM East Northeast of Baler Aurora or 170KM East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.4°N,123.7°E)** with maximum winds of **170 Kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **205 kph**. It is forecast to move **Northwest at 17 Kph**.
