PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "OMPONG" (VONGFONG) was located based on all available data at 788 km east of Itbayat, Batanes (21.0°N, 129.4°E) with maximum winds of 185 kph and gustiness of up to 220 kph. It is forecast to move North at 13 kph. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas Mindanao.
