At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "OMPONG" (VONGFONG) was located based on all available data at **785 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (22.5°N, 129.2°E)**. It is forecast to move North at 13 kph. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao.
