**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM Today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 440 km north northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (12.4°N, 115.8°E). Another Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 540 km east southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (7.0°N, 131.0°E), Meanwhile, the center of Tropical Storm "MERANTI" (INTERNATIONAL NAME) outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 1,460 km east northeast of Legaspi City (15.7°N, 137.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 20 kph.
