At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 610 km East Northeast of Guian Eastern Samar (12.8°N, 131.0°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) which is affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
