At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 650 km east of Borongan City (11.4°N, 131.4°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Palawan, Visayas and Mindanao.
