<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u>Rivers and its Tributaries in:</u> <b>SURIGAO DEL NORTE</b> particularly Surigao and Magallanes. <b>SURIGAO DEL SUR</b> particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bisig. <b>AGUSAN DEL NORTE</b> particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. <b>AGUSAN DEL SUR</b> particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.
