PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "FERDIE" was located based on all available data at 510 KM East of Calayan, Cagayan (19.4°N, 126.3°E) with maximum sustained wind of 215 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 250 KPH. It is forecast to move west northwest at 22 KPH.
