PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "NONA" was located based on all available data including Virac Doppler Radar in the vicinity of Bulusan, Sorsogon (12.7°N, 124.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 150 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 185 kph. It is forecast to move West at 17 kph.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.
